

Postcards and Songs with the VOCES8 Foundation

- Suitable for children in Years 3 and 4
- Spring Term – 2 singing sessions in school led by 2 singing leaders. Sessions to include warm-up activities and songs. All resources provided so class teachers can use the songs and activities.
- Participating classes/children write a postcard to adults who work in the City of London. The adults reply with a postcard for the class or for each child.*
- Class teachers will talk with Ann Wright regarding what they would like the children to write about on their postcards. For example, the postcards could focus on the singing they are doing as part of the project, or something the children are learning that term.
- The Foundation can provide the postcards or a postcard template – whichever the teacher prefers.
- Participating classes will visit the VOCES8 Centre for an interactive workshop and concert with our singers. They will meet the participating adults at this event.

*The adults will all be people who work at businesses in the City of London that support projects with schools. They will be given the school name and the first names of the children. The children in turn will be given the adults' first names and can learn about the adults' jobs if the teacher would like them to.

Each child can write a postcard or if the participating teachers prefer, the postcard can be from the whole class.
