## Charging and Remissions Policy 2023-24

Most of the services provided by THAMES are free of charge.

There is a subsidised fee for attending the Music Centres. From September 2023 these charges will be:

Wednesday Music Centre £43 per term (10 weeks)
Saturday Music Centre £90 per term (10 weeks)

There are exemptions for these charges if in receipt of either:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

To qualify for remission, THAMES will require written evidence of the benefit(s) received. Evidence must be provided on an annual basis.
