### Remissions Policy

Most of the services provided by THAMES are free of charge. There is a subsidised fee for attending the Wednesday and Saturday Music Centres, but there are exemptions for these charges if you are in receipt of either:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

***To qualify for remission, we will require written evidence of the benefit which you receive. Evidence must be provided on an annual basis.***
