

## **Tower Hamlets Arts & Music Education Service**

### **Service Level Agreement for Music**

**September 2023 until July 2024**

The Tower Hamlets Arts & Music Education Service (THAMES) is the lead organisation for the Music Education Hub for Tower Hamlets and the City of London and is funded by the Department for Education.

We provide high quality instrumental/vocal tuition with a free loan of instruments for pupils. We also offer a range of ensembles including an Awards Orchestra, a Big Band, instrument specific groups as well as Children's Choirs, a Tower Hamlets Youth Orchestra, and an inclusive ensemble for disabled and non-disabled pupils, Soundbox. We offer an Awards Scheme for pupils with musical aptitude and offer a wide range of arts and music enrichment projects across all arts disciplines (dance, drama, film and media, music and visual arts). Many of these are offered free to schools. These are delivered by numerous local and nationally recognised cultural partners (see our website). All work delivered by THAMES supports the National Curriculum for Music and Art and the refreshed National Plan for Music Education (NPME) for England.

To reflect this broad offer there is a small termly service charge. For just £100 per term schools have access to further support, resources and advisory services (see Benefits).

Each school has an assigned THAMES Link Manager who can either talk with you on the phone or meet with you in school to discuss your music requirements for 2023-24.

## Benefits

- At cost instrumental, vocal and ensemble tuition (whole class instrumental tuition/ small groups) delivered by highly qualified instrumental tutors
- Tutors are DBS checked and receive regular INSET training, including Safeguarding. All tutors are mentored by THAMES through a Support & Development Programme, including lesson observations as appropriate.
- Bespoke support for ensuring tuition is accessible for all pupils, especially those who may face barriers to instrumental tuition.
- FREE instrumental hire and instrumental repair for all instruments belonging to THAMES
- FREE Award lessons for pupils in KS2 who show musical aptitude and commitment
- FREE advice for all schools in developing their Music Education Development Plans and National Curriculum provision
- FREE Singing Days and other bespoke singing opportunities as part of the THAMES Singing Strategy
- FREE In-service training (INSET) for the arts and music
- FREE networking opportunities including teacher networks for dance, drama, music and the visual arts
- FREE (or at nominal cost) Arts and Music projects, events and workshops for schools
- FREE Concerts and performing opportunities
- FREE support and advice for resources, accommodation and teacher recruitment
- A Wednesday music centre for primary pupils learning orchestral instruments in schools (at nominal cost with remission fees)
- A Saturday music centre for all pupils learning instruments in schools (at nominal cost with remission fees)
- Numerous ensemble opportunities for all pupils learning instruments in schools, including a Youth Orchestra

- **FREE** general advisory support for all aspects of arts and cultural provision in schools including drama, dance, visual arts as well as music. Any additional bespoke work is charged at £400 per day.

## Terms and Costs

All SLAs with schools are for a full academic year. There is an at-cost charge for instrumental, vocal and ensemble tuition, class music teaching and occasionally nominal charges for projects dependent on funding. The weekly instrumental/vocal lessons are charged to schools on a termly basis.

In addition to contact time, some tutors will be paid for an extra 30 minutes each week (if they prepare, set up and pack away multiple instruments for whole class lessons e.g. strings, guitars, percussion). Tutors delivering curriculum music lessons will also be paid for some planning time, negotiated with schools in accordance with the number of lessons taught.

Your THAMES Link Manager will provide you with a projected budget for the music services you have requested for the academic year 2023-24.
